Note to Contributors

The Journal of Rural Development (JRD) is an interdisciplinary journal devoted to the critical analysis and discussion of the current issues of rural development. Empirical, theoretical and historical articles are welcome. It invites notes and comments on the articles it publishes. All contributions should be original pieces and should not be under consideration for publication elsewhere. Articles having more than three authors will be discouraged.

Remuneration for Contribution

The author will get Taka 200.00 (Bangladeshi currency) for each published page of his/her article. In case of more than one author, total honorarium for the article will be equally distributed among the authors.

Instructions of Preparing Typescripts

Articles should include a brief abstract. Articles must be typed double-spaced, on one side only in A4 size paper. A length of not more than 6000 words, including notes and reference, is a useful target. Titles and heading should be clear and brief. Longer quotations to be indented; indicate italics by underlining. In the text, numbers to be spelled out from one to nine and numerals to be used for 10 and over. Notes and source(s) for tables should be placed under each table. Column headings should clearly define the data presented. Camera-ready artwork for all figures must be supplied. Artwork intended for same-size use should have a maximum size of 165: 105 mm over-sized artwork to be made in the same proportions. Use endnotes (not footnotes) and indicate these by superscript numbers in the text. Acknowledgements (if included) should be in the form of an unnumbered note.

Reference cited in the text should be in the form of (Mcquail, 1987:51); (Wilson, 1991); (Beckman, 1987; Clough and Williams, 1987); (Wood, 1987, 1991). Use 'et al' when citing a work by more than two authors, but list all authors in the reference. To distinguish citations of different works by the same author in the same year, use the letter, a, b, c, etc. e.g. (Wilson, 1991a. 1991b). All references cited in the text should be listed alphabetically, beginning on a separate sheet of paper. List author, date, title, place of publication, publisher, page number (for articles and for chapters in edited books), in the following style:
